El significado es exactamente el mismo.

I	have	I	have got	(I've got)
You	have	You	have got	(you've got)
He / she / it	has	He / she / it	has got	(he's got)
We	have	We	have got	(we've got)
You	have	You	have got	(you've got)
They	have	They	have got	(they've got)

= I have time / I have got time. *Tengo tiempo.*

= We have a big house / We have got a big house. *Tenemos una casa grande.*

= They have long hair / They have got long hair. *Tienen pelo largo.*

= She has / She has got an exam tomorrow. *Tiene un examen mañana.*


